### ABP HUMBER PORTS

#### PPE AND SAFE ACCESS REQUIREMENTS FOR PORT USERS

**PORt USERS AND AGENTS ARE REMINDED** that ABP operates strict PPE requirements in all operational areas to ensure the safety of all Port users.

The [Port Rules](#) and [Port Information](#) can be found on the ABP website and agents should promulgate this information to their vessels prior to arrival.

If there is a requirement for ship's crew to transit through the Port, such as for shore leave, or for crew changes, they should:

- Wear appropriate PPE on the quayside.
- Carry a means of identification.
- Make their way directly 'from / to' the gangway 'to / from' the nearest pedestrian walkway or safe access (marked by two yellow lines with a symbol of a person walking).
- **NOT** walk through areas where cargo is working, such as operational quaysides, without first obtaining permission from the ABP cargo supervisor.
- **NOT** access any operational area, building or terminal without permission from the Port Authority or Terminal Operator.

Owners, Agents and Masters may wish to make alternative arrangements for ship's crew to transfer from the ship's gangway to their destination or to a designated location, such as private vehicle, taxi, or transportation service.

ABP is entitled to remove and/or ban any person from the Port if ABP considers that their presence or behaviour may present a danger or give rise to a risk to health, safety, security, order, property or the environment.
